

Controllers' Leadership Forum



The Atlanta Controllers' Leadership Forum led by the Georgia State University J. Mack Robinson School of Business and sponsored by Tatum LLC and Bowne and Co., is a forum to promote the professional development and network of Atlanta area controllers at major private and public companies.

Set to launch in the Fall of 2009, the Controllers' Leadership Forum will host several events throughout the year. Leveraging the resources of GSU and the leadership of a CFO Advisory Board, the programs will promote professional growth and peer relationship building. The Forum will kick-off with a late-summer social.

Membership – Members include corporate and divisional controllers with ten or more years experience in financial or accounting management at a large or mid-size firm who seek to increase their effectiveness and professionalism through networking with peers on business issues and exposure to thought leadership critical to modern controllership.

CFO Advisory Board – By funding and directing the intellectual content of the programs, CFOs signal the importance of networking and development to their controllers and support their professional growth. Advisory members attend two breakfast planning meetings each year and have access to the Georgia State University network all during the year.

Dues – \$400 per calendar year for the first controller. \$200 per calendar year for additional controllers in the same firm.
